Below is a list of suggested materials for purchase. Extra materials will also be provided for use during class time. If you have your own materials, you are encouraged to bring them to the first session. The following materials can be picked up in advance, either locally or online.

1. **Tote Bag, rolling cart, or paintbox to transport materials**
2. **Please bring a kit of oil painting supplies on the first day of class.**
 - a. **Option 1: Students may purchase an Oil or Acrylic Kit from the museum via Susan on the first day of class. The Oil Kit is \$80. The Acrylic Kit is \$70. Checks should be made out to the Cleveland Museum of Art**
 - b. **Option 2: Students may bring their existing supplies to the first class**
3. **Three square (12" x 12") and/or rectangular (16" x 20") canvases**
4. **Two sable brushes: one - size 1 to 4 round, and one filbert shaped sable - size 4**
5. **Several medium size boar hair or synthetic filbert brushes, sizes 6 or 8.**
